

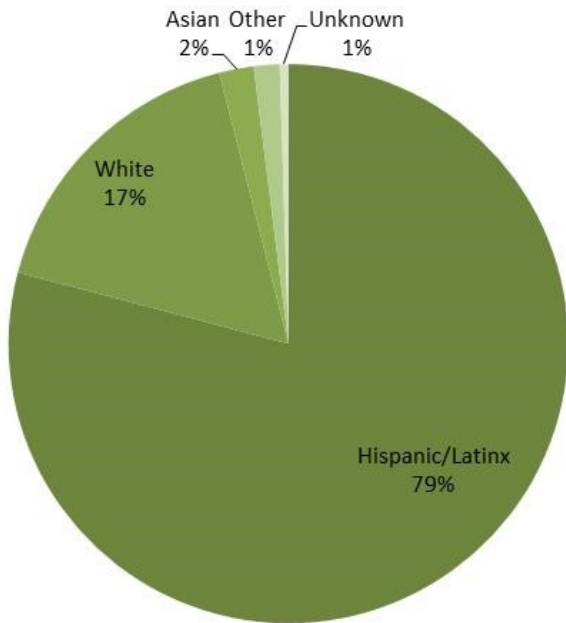

Race/Ethnicity Among COVID-19 Cases in SBC

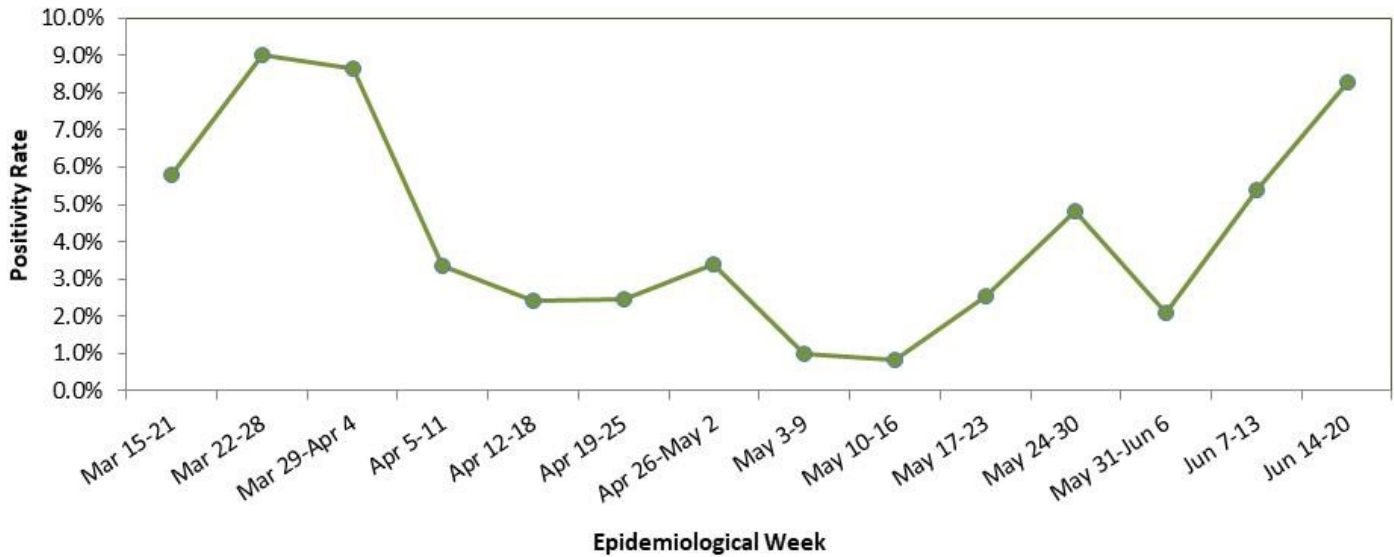

Community transmission (also referred to as community spread or community acquired transmission) occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission (also referred to as contact transmission) occurs when infection is spread through a lab-confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces. Onset date refers to the onset date of symptoms or test date. In SBC, 37% of positive cases work in neighboring counties including: Santa Clara (62%), Monterey (14%) and Santa Cruz (10%).
